This year's projects include building some new games at camp, getting facilities ready for camp, getting the pool ready, and much more.



Pool House Project:

Our Pool House was built in the mid 1980's. It's a wooden structure that is falling apart and we plan to replace it



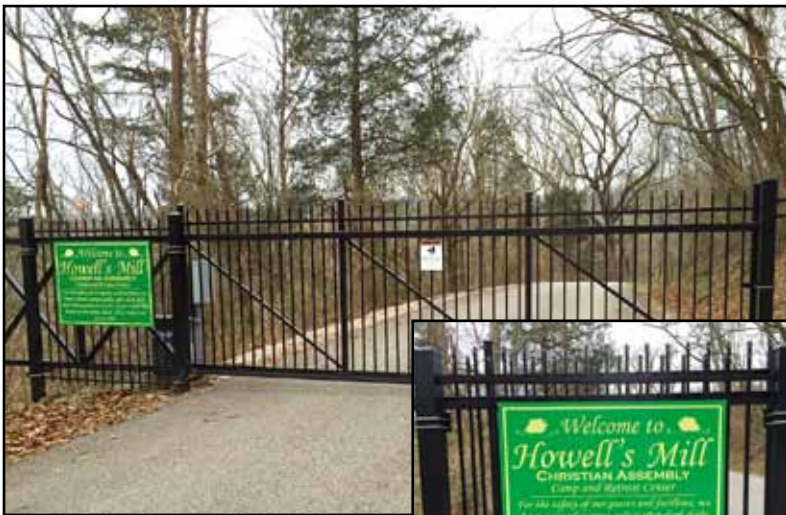
with a block building that will hold up to weather, water, and chemicals much longer. We also have to upgrade some of the concrete

deck and our filters and pumps to stay up with the health department's filtration rate requirements.

This building doesn't only house our pumps and filters, but also contains our pool area bathrooms, and storage for pool chemicals and equipment. Estimated cost \$35,000 to \$40,000.

This Fall, a generous donor pledged to match gifts dollar per dollar up to \$20,000 for gifts given between October 16 and December 10. This pledge excited our camp families and churches who helped us raise \$29,009.06 during that time for the Pool House Remodel and our matching donor gave \$20,000 to bring the total to \$49,009.06 raised for this project! We hope to break ground early in 2015.

New Security Entrance Gate

For the protection of our campground, and the safety of our campers and staff, we have installed an electronic gating system on our main driveway. When guests are onsite, this gate will remain closed and require a security code to enter.

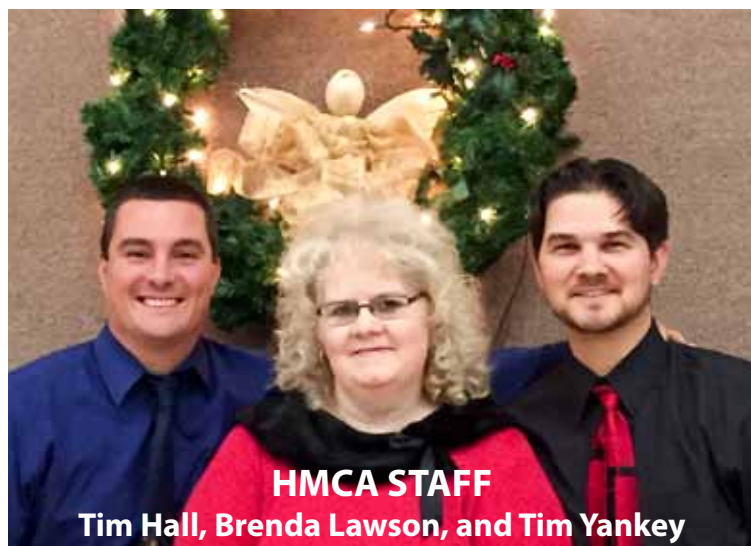
