

New Online Registration System:

We are changing our online registration system to a new company. They are on the east coast and available 24/7, PC1 compliant, and more user friendly. We hope to eventually offer retreat registration online as well. Before, with our older company, costs were too high to justify for 1-2 day events.

Phone-a-thon Fundraiser for Girls Dorm Remodel & Pool House

We plan to have our third phone-a-thon February 17-18 to raise money for these two projects.

The camp board and volunteers made phone calls in 2009, and 2012 to help raise money for camp needs. During those two phone-a-thons we were able to raise \$30,000 each time, update our mailing list, and pray for people in our churches who needed encouragement.

Our two big projects this year:

Remodeling the basement of the Girls Dorm. Years of water damage has led to the need to replace some rotten wood in the back walls, and replace some ceiling tiles, lights, etc. We also hope to add a central heat and air system to this dorm. It's the last main building on site that doesn't have central air and filtration. \$15,000 to \$20,000

Replacing Pool House Shelter. Our pool house was built in the mid 1980's. It's a wooden structure that is falling apart and we need to replace it with a block



building that will hold up to water and chemicals much longer. We also have to upgrade our filters and pumps to meet the health department's filtration rate requirements. Estimated cost is \$10,000 to \$12,000.
